Requirements to be an active member placed on the Pasture Waiting List:

1. *Within not less than 6 months, and no more than 12 months*, attend 4 general membership meetings, participate in 3 activities, and work 5 hours in the pasture.
2. The 5 required pasture work hours for all new pasture applicants will be with a mentor who is a representative of the pasture committee. The pasture manager will designate the mentor for each applicant; this mentor will continue to assist the new Pasture member when they are offered a space and introduce their horse into the pasture.
3. The application date will be the day the application is presented to the Vice President, *however*, a space may not be offered to the applicant until the active membership requirements (as detailed in #1 above) for the Pasture Waiting List have been met.

It is highly recommended that all applicants make an effort to join in riding activities with the club so that people and horses become better acquainted. If your horse is not presently in a pasture, we suggest you try boarding in such a situation while you wait for your spot. It will make the transition into the MHA pasture much easier.
